message status query

Introduction

If you would like to know the latest status of a specific message, you will have to pass a set of variables to the gateway through a HTTP connection. This connection can either be made using the GET or de POST method.

The URL you need to pass the variables to is <http://api.imezz.com/status.asp>

The different variables that need to be passed to the gateway are:

Your username:	u
Your password:	p
The message ID:	id

Variables explained

The message ID

This is an ID you have received after sending a message. This ID is assigned to the message by the server and is used to identify the specific message you are querying.

Query example

<http://api.imezz.com/status.asp?u=username&p=password&id=a809809cdsc98809>

Server response

Whenever the URL (like the examples above) is called, you will get a response from the server. The response will always look like this

ID: <message id> Status: <status code>

Status codes

001:	message unknown
002:	message queued
003:	message delivered to gateway
004:	message received by recipient
005:	message contains errors
006:	message delivery was cancelled
007:	message could not be delivered
008:	OK
009:	message could not be routed
010:	message expired
011:	message queued for later delivery
